Scholarship Application

Friends of the Verde River is pleased to announce the 2025 Young Birders Camp Scholarship competition. The Young Birders Camp brings kids like you together to learn about birds, nature, ecology, and conservation. The camp activities include field trips observing birds and other animals, presentations by experts, and fun time in the beautiful outdoors.

Friends of the Verde River will award one scholarship to one young person and their adult sponsor (parent or guardian) to attend the 2025 Young Birders Camp. The camp is in the beautiful and bird-rich Cave Creek Canyon of the Chiricahua Mountains, June 5 - 8, 2025.

Applications for the scholarship are due no later than March 21 to VVBNF@Verderiver.org. You must be between the ages of 8 – 18 (as of June 1st) to be eligible.

When is the camp? | June 5-8, 2025

Where is the camp? | Portal, Arizona, at the Southwestern Research Station

Who is eligible to apply? | Arizona youths aged 8 – 18 as of June 1, 2025

The scholarship covers the cost of camp, including meals and lodging, for two people (youth plus their adult sponsor), plus a travel allowance of \$100.

How do I apply? | Complete the application form and submit it via email to VVBNF@VerdeRiver.org by Friday, March 21, 2025.

When will I hear back? | The winner will be notified by Friday, April 18, 2025

What else? | The winner is requested to attend the Keynote Dinner (at no cost) and be introduced; the Keynote Dinner is Friday, April 25.
